## **BEACH REMINDERS - ONE MORE TIME...**

**WHAT GOES DOWN – MUST COME BACK!** This is becoming a BIGGER problem. Chairs are NOT to be left on the beach overnight. Garbage needs to be taken with you when you leave the beach. Simply put – anything you bring to the beach MUST be taken with you at the end of the day.

**DEFECATING IN THE DUNES / PRIVATE PROPERTY!** This continues and it is not acceptable. Our suspicion is that the people doing this have trespassed on private property to get to the beach; and since Deanlea does not have a public washroom – they use the dunes? If that is the case and you see someone coming out of the dunes – ask them. We are not saying it is easy, but it could be the only way to stop it.

**DOGS ON THE BEACH!** Dog owners are reminded that **dogs are not allowed on the beach between 12:00 noon and 5:00 pm during the months of July and August** due to the number of people on the beach. This is a long standing practice at Deanlea Beach. Also, please remember that your dog must be on a leash at all times.

**PARKING ON MUNICIPAL ROADS!** Can people park on Municipal Roads? The short answer is "yes" as long as they have a Tiny Township parking permit. However, and this is what you need to know, if they park and then go to the beach via the private roads and footpaths – they are **TRESPASSING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY**. That is why we have signs that say "No public beach access." If you see anyone parking, first check to see if they have a parking permit – if NO, call By-law **(705) 526-4204**. If YES and they go to the beach – call OPP.
